Fact Sheet for Universities

The Helmholtz Investigator Groups program

The Helmholtz Investigator Groups program provides the opportunity to set up and lead a research group for excellent scientists from Germany and abroad. The program aims to foster the early scientific independence of researchers. It offers excellent working conditions in a research-intensive environment as well as attractive and permanent career prospects based on proven scientific achievements. Since the start of the program in 2003, more than 275 recipients have been awarded funding for their research group at a Helmholtz Center.

Universities as important strategic partners

The Helmholtz Association's most important strategic partners are universities. Close cooperation with them plays a key role in the Helmholtz Investigator Group program. This cooperation allows group leaders to experience the benefits of a collaborative culture based on the division of labor when striving to achieve a common goal. At the same time, they have the opportunity to gain teaching experience and qualify for a professorship. The Helmholtz Association supports all efforts to jointly appoint the selected Helmholtz Investigator Group leaders to professorships at the partner universities.

A Helmholtz Investigator Group may be based at a university, a Helmholtz Center, or both. However, the group is expected to agree on clearly defined tasks at each of the institutions. These tasks must be set out in detail in the planned work schedule.

Selection procedure

The applications are assessed in a multi-stage selection process that meets the highest quality standards. In the first stage, the Helmholtz Center performs a pre-selection. After nomination by the Helmholtz Centers and a formal eligibility check, all candidates are invited to present their proposals to one of several interdisciplinary expert panels. Each panel includes international reviewers with relevant scientific expertise. Following the presentations and subsequent panel deliberations, the panels make the final funding recommendations.

University statement

A written statement by the university board (or another authorized university representative) and the relevant department/faculty is required to confirm the rights and responsibilities of the Helmholtz Investigator Group leader in accordance with the applicable higher education laws of the federal state. The statement must address the following points:

- teaching responsibilities (maximum of four semester hours per week);
- research independence;
- supervision of doctoral candidates;
- access to all necessary resources and infrastructure;
- staff and budget responsibilities (if applicable).

The form for the university statement is provided below. This statement must be submitted to the Helmholtz Head Office after funding approval and before the official start of the group.
