The abstract must be no longer than one (1) page and you can arrange text and figures as you like.

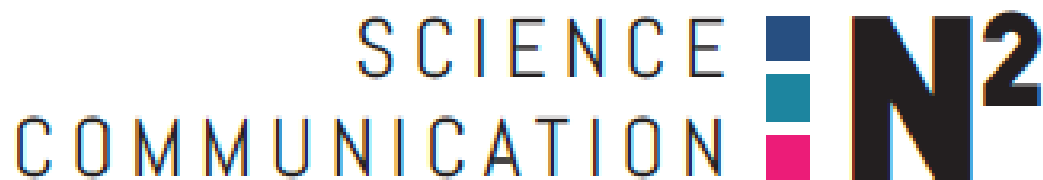


Figure 1: This is a larger, centered version of the conference logo. Here, you can insert your own figures, captions, etc. The abstract can also consist of figures only, as long as a context is understandable.
